#### VIRGINIA SWEETSPIRE, Itea virginica



• Light: Sun to part shade

Soil: Well-drained

Moisture: Tolerates moisture

• Size: To 10 feet

• Zone: 5 - 9

This easy to grow native adds beauty to the garden for months, starting with fragrant white flowers in the summer and ending the year with deep purple foliage.



#### DIERVILLA, Diervilla lonicera



• Light: Full sun to part shade

Soil: Well-drained

Moisture: Medium

• Size: 3 to 4 feet

• Zone: 4 – 8

An easy to grow native shrub that will tolerate clay soil. Sometimes called bush honeysuckle, but they are not invasive.



## SMOKEBUSH, Cotinus cogygria



• Light: Part shade to shade

Soil: Well-drained

Moisture: Tolerates moisture

• Size: To 15 feet

• Zone: 5 - 8

A multi-season treasure! Beginning in late spring and continuing into summer, feathery plumes cover the bush. Summer foliage can be purple or gold with leaves turning brilliant orange in fall.



## WITCH HAZEL, Hamamelis virginiana



• Light: Shade

Soil: Well-drained

Moisture: Tolerates moisture

• Size: To 12 feet

• Zone: 3 – 8

One of the earliest native shrubs to bloom. Valued for its spidery yellow flowers, the golden fall foliage is another plus.



#### FOTHERGILLA, Fothergilla major



• Light: Shade

Soil: Well-drained

Moisture: Tolerates moisture

• Size: 5 to 6 feet

• Zone: 5 to 8

Attractive native for those difficult spots. Blue-green spring foliage, gold in autumn; hint of honey scent in its blooms.



#### **VIBURNUM**



• Light: Sun to part shade

Soil: Well-drained

Moisture: Tolerates moisture

• Size: By variety, 3 to 16 feet

• Zone: 2 to 7

Gorgeous blooms early spring that attracts butterflies and other pollinators; berries for birds in the winter; disease resistant; a real winner



#### SUMAC, Rhus typhina



• Light: Full Sun

• Soil: Well-drained

• Moisture: Moderate

• Size: To 15 feet

• Zone: 3 – 8

Native shrub with exceptional fall color; tendency to spread



# NINEBARK, Physocarpus opulifolius



• Light: Full sun to part shade

Soil: Well-drained; Slightly acidic

Moisture: Medium to dry

• Size: 5 - 8 feet

• Zone: 2 – 8

White to pink blooms cover this native shrub May through June. Mature branches features beautiful peeling bark.
