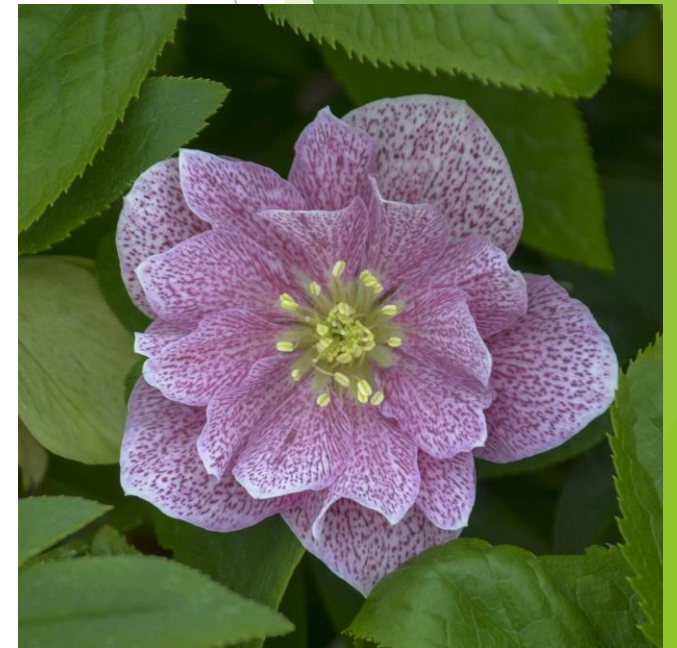


'Maid of Honor'

Helleborus



Part to full shade perennials *** Blooms in early spring *** 18 - 24 inches high
Average soil *** Zones 4 - 9 *** Beneficial for early bees

'Pretty in Pink'
Pulmonaria

Shade perennial *** Blooms late spring *** 14 -16 inches high

Average soil *** Zones 3 - 9 *** Pollinator friendly

'Miss Piggy'
Bergenia

Full sun full shade perennial *** Blooms early to late spring *** 16 - 18 inches high
Fertile soil preferred for maximum bloom *** Zones 4 - 8 *** Bee friendly

'Gold Heart'
Dicentra spectabilis

Part to full shade perennial *** Blooms in late spring *** 18 - 24 inches high
Average soil *** Zones 3 - 9 *** Bee friendly

'Pinky Promise'
Dianthus

Full to part sun perennial *** Blooms early summer/fall *** 6 - 8 inches high
Average soil *** Zones 4 - 9 *** Butterfly and bee friendly

'Pinky Pie'
Agastache

Native perennial for full sun *** Blooms mid to late summer *** 18 - 20 inches high

Dry, rocky soil *** Zones 5 - 9 *** Hummingbird magnet

'Fancy Girl'
Phlox paniculata

Native Full to partial sun *** Blooms midsummer into fall *** 24 - 30 inches high
Average soil *** Zones 3 - 8 *** Pollinator friendly and disease resistant

'All Eyes on Me'
Hibiscus

Native full sun perennial *** Blooms midsummer into fall *** 3 - 4 feet high

Average to poor soil *** Zone 4 - 9 *** Butterfly friendly

'Pure Joy' Sedum

Abby's pick

'Pure Joy' Sedum

Full sun perennial *** Blooms late summer into fall *** 10 - 12 inches high
Average to poor soil *** Zones 3 - 9 *** Butterfly and bee friendly

Dahlias

Full sun annual * Bloom from midsummer until frost *** 1 - 4 feet high**

Well-drained, organically rich soil * Plant when the ground has warmed to 60 degrees**



Asters

Native sun loving perennial *** Fall bloomer *** 1 - 6 feet high, depending
on variety *** Average soil *** Essential for late season pollinators



Nemesia

Primarily grown as part sun/part shade annual *** Strong spring bloom *** 10 - 18 inches high
Well-drained, organic soil *** Light fragrance



Cosmos

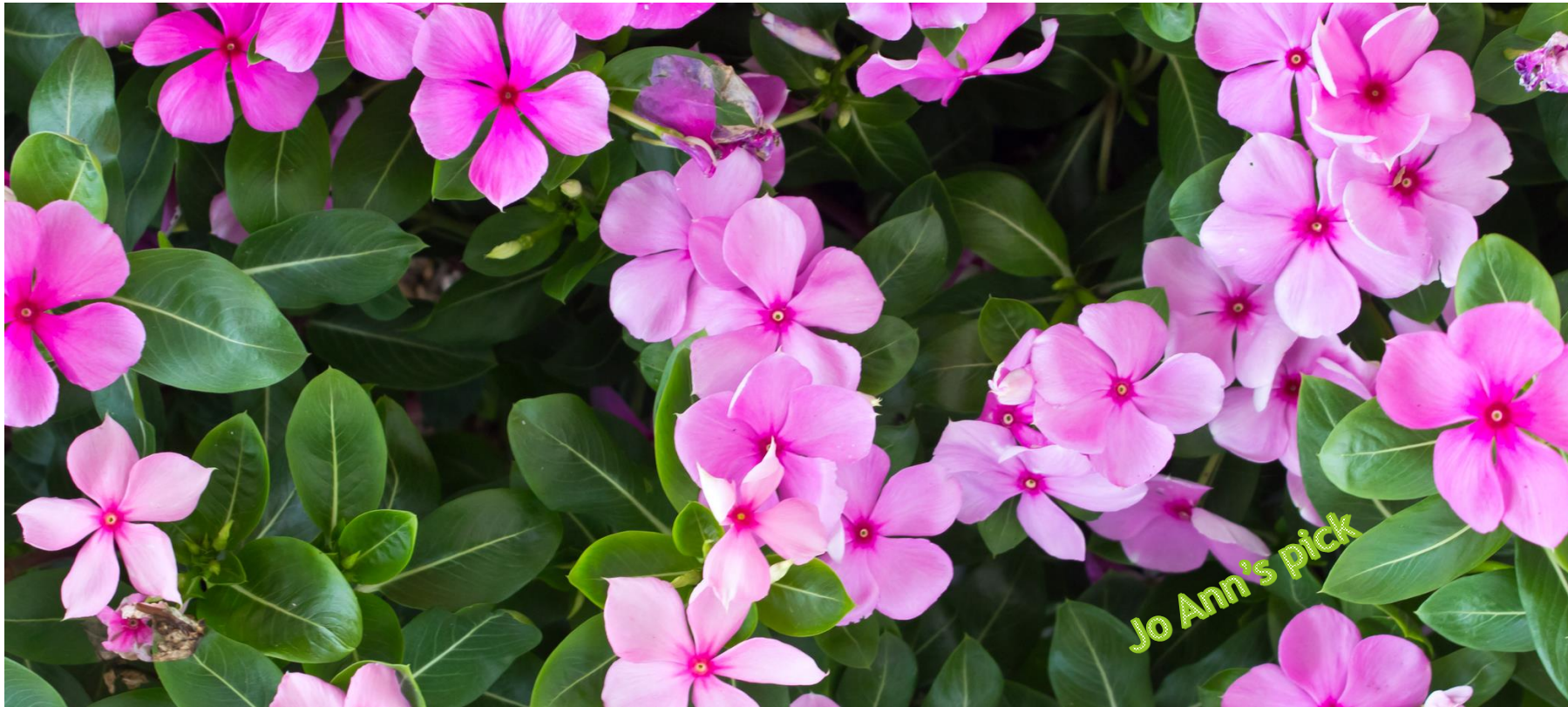
Full sun annual *** Blooms early summer through fall *** 2 - 6 feet tall

Average to poor soil *** Attracts songbirds and butterflies



Snapdragons

Hardy annuals that prefer full sun and cooler temperatures *** Blooms profusely in spring and fall *** 6 - 48 inches high *** Bee friendly



Vinca

Full sun annual *** Blooms from late spring through fall *** 8 - 24 inches high

Average to poor soil *** Pollinator friendly



Petunia

Popular sun-loving annual * Blooms from early spring throughout fall**

6 -18 inches high * Average, well-drained soil *** Especially valuable for moths**



Impatiens

Shade loving annual * Blooms spring through fall *** 6 - 36 inches high**

Well-drained, acidic soil * Appreciate consistent moisture *** Bee and butterfly friendly**



Caladiums

Tropical plants that thrive in a filtered sun location *** Known for colorful foliage rather than blooms *** Plant in warm, rich, well-drained soil



Begonia semperflorens

Partial sun to shade loving annual *** Blooms from spring through fall,
depending on variety *** 6 - 18 inches high *** Rich, well-drained soil
Some varieties attract pollinators



Dipladenia

Vining tropical plant that prefers afternoon shade *** Blooms spring through fall *** 1 - 2 feet high with climbing stems *** Attracts hummikingbirds



Muhlenbergia reverchonii

Full sun native grass *** Blooms August through November *** 3 feet tall

Zones 5 - 9 *** Dry, rocky soil *** Attracts butterflies and bees



Hydrangea *arborescens*

Native shrub loving part to full sun *** Continuous summer bloomer

48 - 60 inches high *** Zones 3 - 8 *** Average soil *** Smaller florets offer nectar to butterflies



'Pink Cascade II'
Buddleia

Flowering shrub *** Blooms late spring to early fall *** 4 feet high

Average soil *** Zones 5 - 10 *** Butterflies, bees and hummingbirds love it

'Sweet Macchiato'

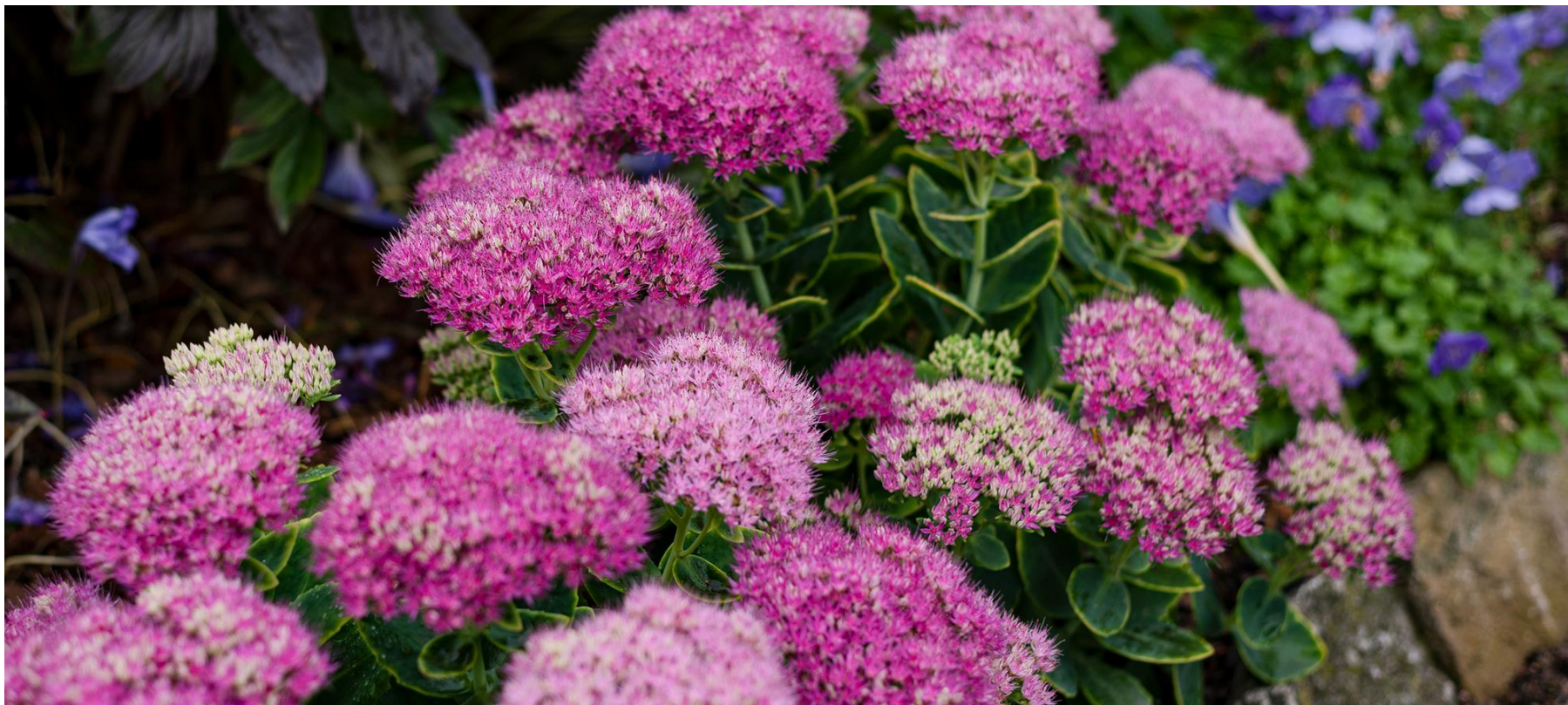
Lagerstroemia

(Crape Myrtle)

Full sun small shrub *** Blooms late summer into fall *** 2.5 - 3 feet high

Average soil *** Zones 6 - 9 *** Especially bee friendly

“Little Princess” Spirea

Sun loving shrub *** Blooms throughout the summer *** 3 feet high

Zones 4 - 9 *** Average, well-drained soil *** Pollinator friendly
